Note: Due to U.S. Department of Homeland Security and China government requirements, our travel agent must submit all NP:C participants' passports to a Chinese embassy 60 days prior to departure. Please be sure to give your passport and a passport picture of yourself to your teacher by March 2, 2010 so that NP:C will receive your group's passports in a timely manner. Any copies received late will require special administrative attention thereby incurring a \$50 late fee (please refer to the *Important Details* document).

If you are applying for a new or renewal passport, submit your passport application **IMMEDIATELY** upon acceptance to NP:C. It may take 3 months to get a passport.

- **I have read and fully understand the document entitled *Important Details with special attention to the sections on Additional Fees and Cancellation Refund Policies and NP:C Rules for Participant Behavior*.**
- The Laurasian Institution will not be held liable for any of the actions or negligence of any third parties including, but not limited to, commercial airlines, hotels, and restaurants.
- The Laurasian Institution, the host school, and host family are not and will not be held liable for any injuries to me or my possessions.
- The Laurasian Institution is not responsible for providing insurance coverage of any kind during the NP:C program. I understand and agree that I am responsible for my own insurance including, but not limited to, health, travel, and life insurance. Furthermore, I understand that I am required to have and show proof of health insurance coverage abroad for the duration of my NP:C tour.
- Any and all debts incurred by me during this program including, but not limited to, medical, dental, hospital bills, and personal expenses (e.g. long distance calls) incurred during the homestay are my own responsibility and will not be paid by The Laurasian Institution.
- The Laurasian Institution reserves the right to change or alter travel, lodging, or other arrangements without notice or reason.
- The Laurasian Institution may remove me from the program at any time for reasons TLI staff deems sufficient including, but not limited to, my health, attitude, or behavior. Expenses incurred for such removal are my responsibility and must be paid by me immediately upon demand.
- I am of sound physical and mental condition and have no medical problems or disabilities that have not been set forth in writing attached hereto or which would make participation in this program inadvisable. Furthermore, I understand that extensive walking and stair climbing are part of everyday Japanese life and culture, and **I will be physically and mentally prepared for EXTENSIVE WALKING AND STAIR CLIMBING during the NP:C tour.**
- All costs that are not explicitly included in the program are my own responsibility.
- Photos taken of me during the course of the tour may be uploaded to the NP:C website and used in promotional materials.
- Due to scheduling difficulties beyond NP:C's control, homestay families may not be confirmed until days prior to your departure for China. NP:C will, of course, make every effort to encourage host families to submit their information in a timely manner.
- I understand that family members who are not participants in the NP:C program are not allowed to shadow me or my group.
- **My valid passport will be provided to the organizing teacher by March 2, 2010 and postmarked to NP:C by March 15, 2010. I understand that if my passport fails to meet this deadline, a US\$50 late fee will be incurred.**
- If I have applied for a scholarship and am awarded one, I will submit the required project or report by November 30, 2010.
